MEMBERSHIP DUES

- FULL (\$25)** Any person employed in a professional capacity in a local government or urban management profession, including regional councils of government, public utilities and other urban management agencies which provide services to local communities.
- COOPERATING (\$40)** Any person who is employed by a private-for-profit organization that provides services to local governments or any person interested in the promotion of urban management but is not qualified for any other category of membership.
- STUDENT (\$10)** Any person enrolled in a public administration program who is not currently employed in a full-time urban management position.
- LEGACY (\$20)** Any person who is a current or retired city manager, deputy or assistant city manager, executive level governmental official or former active UMPSET member.

Please note: Voting rights are extended to Full, Student, and Legacy Members only; all elected officers of the Association shall be Full or Student Members.
